

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS FOR WOOD DOOR SCHEDULES

A COMPLETE SET OF ARCHITECTURAL DOOR FORMS CONSISTS OF:

- Schedule A** - Architectural Wood Door Schedule
- Schedule B** - Prefit and Machining Door Schedule
- Schedule C** - Door Identification Codes
- Schedule D** - Interior Blocking (Screw Reinforcements)
- Schedule E** - Door Elevation Sheet
- Schedule F** - Door Sectional Details
- Schedule G** - Stile & Rail, Sketchface and Applied Moulding Elevations
- Schedule H** - Prefit and Machining Frame Schedule

Note: All forms may be copied and used to make up a complete wood door shop drawing for use in obtaining architect's approval. When approved, they should be sent to the wood door manufacturer along with your purchase order.

Coordination Credit:

Eggers Industries will provide a credit to your order when given all of the following information in the initial paperwork submission:

- **Completed Schedule A form**, including Quote Number
- **Completed Schedule B form**, including Prefit Door Size, Hardware Template Number(s), Hardware Location(s), Hardware Manufacturer(s), Interior Blocking Information from Schedule D (if necessary), Door Elevations from Schedule E (if necessary)
- **Completed Schedule D and Schedule E** (if necessary)

Please Note: A completed Schedule A form must accompany all orders.

The instructions for each sheet are as follows:

Schedule A	This form is meant to serve as the cover sheet on the number of forms involved with a job.
Schedule B	Use one or more of these forms as needed. Doors that have the same size, construction, hardware machining locations, fire rating and lite or louver openings can be combined on one sheet.
Schedule C	This is a list of the door codes to be used for "core types" on Schedule B
Schedule D	This schedule is to be used to select the type of reinforcement blocking required on mineral and wood core doors. These model numbers should be entered in the box for blocking on Schedule B.
Schedule E	Use this schedule to make any shop drawings necessary to show the architect and the door supplier appropriate details of single doors, Dutch doors and pairs of doors. Reference elevation type on Schedule B.
Schedule F	This schedule is used to select specific profiles or details. Use associated number on other schedules in appropriate boxes.
Schedule G	Use this schedule to make any shop drawings necessary to show appropriate details for stile & rail doors, sketchface doors or applied moulding. Please reference these elevations on Schedule B.
Schedule H	Use one or more of these forms as needed. Frames that have the same size, construction, hardware machining locations, fire rating and lite or louver openings can be combined on one sheet.
