



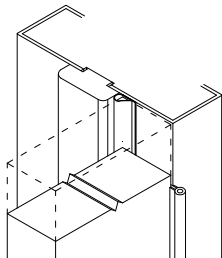

Doors intended for use in Smoke Partitions are, by code, non-rated". The label they bear indicates compliance with air leakage testing per UL-1784 only.

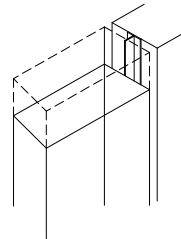
To comply with air leakage requirements a smoke control seal must be installed within the door-to-frame clearance as well as between leaves of pair doors or meeting rails of Dutch doors and door / transom assemblies.

The drawings below show typical installations. The seals indicated are for example, and any Category G smoke and draft control seal may be used. Different types of seals offer different advantages for specific applications. This instruction is not intended as a guide to the type of seal used for any specific opening.

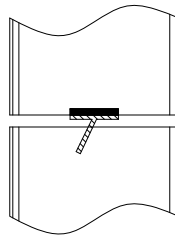
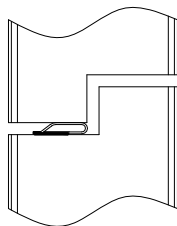
Door to Frame Seal
